

UMRAH VISA



General Information:

An Umrah visa allows Muslims to travel to Saudi Arabia to perform the Umrah pilgrimage, visiting the holy cities of Mecca and Medina, and is valid for a specific duration, typically 90 days,

- **Purpose:** The primary purpose of an Umrah visa is to allow Muslims to perform the Umrah pilgrimage, a lesser pilgrimage to Mecca, at any time of the year except during the Hajj season.
- **Duration of Stay:** While the visa is valid for 90 days, the duration of stay is limited to the time needed to perform Umrah and other approved activities, and overstaying is not advised.
- **Restrictions:** Umrah visas do not permit work or residency in Saudi Arabia.
- **Hajj:** Umrah visas are not valid for performing the Hajj pilgrimage, which requires a separate Hajj visa.

Requirements for:

- A Bangladeshi passport is valid for at least 6 months.
- Biometric complete copy must be given to us.
- File processing for visa will start only after receiving all necessary documents.
- **Note:** The full cost of the Umrah visa must be prepaid.
